Cat Burglar strikes in the Township

Township of Washington Police Chief Randy Ciocco announces two residential burglaries that occurred on Wednesday, October 7, 2012.

On the morning of October 7, 2012 two separate residents on Hampshire Rd in the Township notified Township PD that they had been burglarized. Patrol responded to both locations and in both instances the homes had been broken into while the occupants were sleeping. Access was gained through an unlocked door at one residence and the other a door was pried open. Jewelry and cash were the proceeds.

Residents are reminded to lock all doors to their homes and report any suspicious activity immediately.

The Township of Washington is located in the northern portion of Bergen County, which is in the far northeastern corner of New Jersey, 15 miles northwest of New York City. The Washington Twp. Police Department was established by ordinance in April 1934, and expanded, along with the town, in the 1950's. Presently, the Township of Washington has approximately 10,000 residents who are protected by 21 full-time sworn police officers, under the direction of Police Chief Randy Ciocco. Community policing initiatives and educational outreach throughout the community are among the top priorities for the department's organizational focus.
