EMERGENCY RESOLUTION-ORDINANCE 17-01

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b) provides that an ordinance may take effect less than 20 days after final passage and approval if the Township Council shall adopt a resolution declaring an emergency, and at least two-thirds of all the members of the Township Council vote in favor of such resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Washington has determined that an emergency exists in connection with parking on Colonial Boulevard from Ridgewood Road to Lincoln Place, and that such emergency as well as the general welfare of the Township of Washington would be served by having Ordinance No. 17-01 take effect less than 20 days after final passage and approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington that Ordinance No. 17-01 shall take effect immediately pursuant to law upon the adoption of this Resolution by at least two-thirds of all the members of the Township Council.
