WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b) provides that an ordinance may take effect less than 20 days after final passage and approval if the Township Council shall adopt a resolution declaring an emergency, and at least two-thirds of all the members of the Township Council vote in favor of such resolution; and


WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Washington has determined that an emergency exists in connection with fees related to Ordinance No. 19-05, and that such emergency as well as the general welfare of the Township of Washington would be served by having Ordinance No. 19-05 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES FOR SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM ACTIVITIES AND RELATED SERVICES take effect less than 20 days after final passage and approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington that Ordinance No. 19-05 shall take effect immediately pursuant to law upon the adoption of this resolution by at least two-thirds of all the members of the Township Council.
