RESOLUTION No. 20-219

AUTHORIZING SOLID WASTE SERVICE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Municipal and County Utilities Authorities Law (N.J.S.A. 40:14B et seq.) and the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) authorizes and permits contracting units, such as the Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "BCUA") and the Township of Washington (the "Township") to enter into service agreements for the services contemplated below and without competitive bidding for same, pursuant to and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(2); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the New Jersey Solid Waste Management Act (N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1 et seq.) the County of Bergen, constitutes a Solid Waste Management District in which the BCUA is the agency responsible for implementation of a Solid Waste Management Plan to provide for the collection, processing and disposal of solid waste generated within the County of Bergen; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue its Solid Waste Cooperative Marketing Program, the BCUA advertised for bids for solid waste processing, transport and disposal services; and

WHEREAS, Covanta Sustainable Solutions, LLC ("Covanta") was awarded a contract with the BCUA on April 26, 2018, (the "Contract") for the acceptance, processing and disposal of municipal solid waste at their disposal facilities located at 301 Maltese Drive, Totowa, NJ 07512 and 20-32 Fulton Street, Paterson, NJ at a total cost of \$66.39 per ton for the period June 1, 2018 through May 31, 2020 and now extending this contract until May 31, 2021 at a cost of \$69.05 per ton; and

WHEREAS, the BCUA has proposed a form of Solid Waste Service Agreement with the Township under letter dated May 6, 2020 ("the Agreement"); and


WHEREAS, the Township Council is in need of such solid waste services and desires to enter into the Agreement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Washington, that the Township hereby approves the Agreement.
