RESOLUTION No. 21-247

(LSRP – DPW Site Remediation)

WHEREAS, the Township requires professional services of a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (“LSRP”) in connection with soil remediation and related services at the Township’s Department of Public Works (“DPW”) site; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (“NJDEP”) requires that the Township retain and utilize an LSRP pursuant to the Site Remediation Reform Act (*N.J.S.A. 58:10C-1 et seq.*) for such environmental services; and

WHEREAS, Lisko Environmental, LLC has presented a professional environmental proposal for soil remediation at the DPW site dated May 24, 2021 which is on file at the office of the Township Clerk, which services are necessary to comply with the requirements of the Site Remediation Reform Act (SRRA) and Administrative Requirements for the Remediation of Contaminated Sites (ARRCS); and

WHEREAS, Lisko Environmental, LLC is the successor LSRP firm to Quest Environmental & Engineering Services, Inc. (“Quest”), the Township’s LSRP, and the principal of Quest who is now part of Lisko Environmental, LLC has the historical background, testing data and knowledge of the environmental conditions and requirements relating to remediation of the soil contamination and other remediation requirements related to the DPW Site; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to retain Lisko Environmental, LLC as the Township’s LSRP and authorize it to undertake site remediation of the DPW site in accordance with its proposal; and

WHEREAS, Lisko Environmental, LLC has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of Washington in the previous one year, or made any contribution not in accordance with the terms of the applicable Township ordinance, and has agreed that the terms of appointment will prohibit Lisko Environmental, LLC from making any reportable contributions during the term of the contract or making any contribution not in conformity with the terms of the applicable Township ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Washington, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey hereby retains and appoints Lisko Environmental, LLC as the Township's Licensed Site Remediation Professional in connection with soil remediation and related services at the Township's Department of Public Works site in accordance with its aforesaid proposal;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the position set forth herein was not filled through the "fair and open process" as defined under N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq. As such, it has been attested that Lisko Environmental, LLC, and any subsidiaries, assigns or principals controlling in excess of 10% of said company has neither made a contribution that is reportable pursuant to the Election Law Enforcement Commission pursuant to N.J.S A. 19:44A-8 or 19:44A-16, in the one (1) year period preceding the appointment that would, pursuant to P.L. 2004, c.19, affect the eligibility to perform under the appointment, nor will it make a reportable contribution during the term of the contract to any political party committee in the Township of Washington, County of Bergen, or make any contribution which is not in conformity with Township ordinance, when the contract is awarded, or to any candidate committee of any person servicing in an elective public office of said municipality when the contract is awarded;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute the May 24, 2021 proposal of Lisko Environmental, LLC subject to legal modifications as may be required by the Township Attorney;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this expenditure shall be charged to Account No(s). C-04-55-895-101 or any other account that may be deemed appropriate by the Chief Financial Officer;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification be placed on file with this resolution, and that a notice of the within award of contract shall be published in accordance with law.

CERTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS


