On or about Monday, August 3, 2020 (weather permitting), construction will commence on the above-referenced project. The work to be performed includes the milling and resurfacing of the following roads:

- Cosman Street from Ridgewood Road South to End of PSEG Trench
- Prospect Avenue
- Calvin Street – 100 Feet South of Sunset Lane to Howard Street
- Crestwood Terrace from Calvin Street to 428 Crestwood Terrace
- Robinwood Road from Jackson Avenue to Washington Avenue
- Woodfield Road from Finnerty Place to Devon Road
- Viola Terrace
- Salem Road
- Johnson Place

This work is funded by a Local Aid Grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation and the Township of Washington

Homeowners will experience delays with access to and from the residences during the milling and paving operations, which normally take two (2) days to complete. No Parking and construction/detour signs will be posted along the roadway at least 24 hours prior to the start of the milling and paving on the road. Please keep in mind that inclement weather will delay construction. Please move your vehicle(s) off the street by 7:00 A.M. on the dates indicated on the signs. If you will not be utilizing your vehicle(s) during construction, it is not necessary to remove it/them from your driveway, but please keep in mind that you will not have any access to drive on the road during the paving operations, which will be performed the day after milling, weather permitting. Access to the street will be limited until approximately 5:00 P.M. on days of construction. Every effort will be made to assure that inconveniences are minimal and all work will be completed as quickly as possible.
