February 1, May 1, August 1, November 1 - with a grace period of 10 days inclusive of the due date, unless otherwise noted. Payments not received by the end of grace period will be charged interest accruing back to the due date of the 1st. Post mark dates are not accepted under any circumstances! Payments must be received in the Tax Office by the due date/grace period.






WHAT TO DO WITH UNUSED MEDICATION?

1. You must be a registered voter in order to apply for a Vote by Mail Ballot.
2. Once you apply for a Vote by Mail Ballot, you will not be permitted to vote by machine at your polling place in the same election.
3. You will receive instructions with your ballot.
4. If returning your Vote by Mail Ballot in person it must be received by the County Board of Elections before close of polls on Election Day. If returning your Vote by Mail in Ballot by mail, it must be postmarked no later than Election Day and received by the County Board of Elections no later than 48 hours after the time of the closing of the polls for the election.
5. Do not submit more than once application for the same election.
6. Once you apply for Vote by Mail Ballot, the County Clerk's Office will send you a Vote By Mail Ballot for ALL FUTURE ELECTIONS unless you notify their office in writing that you do not wish to receive a Vote By Mail Ballot in the future.


In 2020, we continue to offer a number of special events for all members of the community. The Library is handicapped accessible and welcomes residents of all abilities to library programs.





